FSC Risk Assessment Framework

FSC-PRO-60-006b FSC Risk Assessment Framework provides a comprehensive tool for companies to assess and mitigate risks of sourcing forest materials.

With 64 indicators for assessing risks connected to relevant social and environmental aspects, FSC's Risk Assessment Framework is aligned with EUDR regulatory requirements to ensure responsible sourcing. The next generation of FSC's existing risk assessments for controlled wood sourcing will be based on this updated framework and valid for both **Regulatory Module users** and Controlled Wood users. Consultations for FSC Risk Assessment development and revision

In accordance with FSC's Risk Assessment Framework all FSC Risk Assessments developed centrally will have a focused consultation.

A focused consultation is one where ALL stakeholders can self-identify themselves as interested in a particular normative revision/ development. Once a stakeholder self identifies themselves then they will be actively contacted to participate in consultation.

The rationale to differentiate between public and focused consultations was to streamline FSC processes wherein only interested stakeholders are invited to participate in the consultations. This is also expected to reduce the stakeholder fatigue with all the ongoing FSC consultations.

How can I participate in consultations for FSC Risk Assessments?

To facilitate stakeholders to self-identify we have created a **simple form** published on the **FSC Country Requirements Schedule page** on FSC Connect. When the consultations for indicated FSC Risk Assessments are open you will be emailed with a link to participate.

In addition, links to open consultations are posted to this page as well.

Limitations of FSC Consultation Platform

All country requirements consultations are posted to the FSC Consultation Platform. The standard developers can also build their own platforms if that better fits the needs of their constituency. As such, country requirements consultations are not visible when opening the FSC Consultation Platform page as they are not defined as "public" in our normative requirements. We are working on an updated Consultation Platform that will be able to differentiate this better and allow for better user orientation.

Engagement for FSC Risk Assessment development and revisions

Our standard developers are responsible for using various mechanisms for their outreach in their respective geographies for requirements (regional or national). Additional stakeholders are typically identified through:

1. The stakeholder list provided by FSC Network Partners
2. Self-generated stakeholder list by standard developers
3. Using standard developers' own IT platforms and sign-up tools (where available)
4. Stakeholder meeting with interested stakeholders (if planned)
