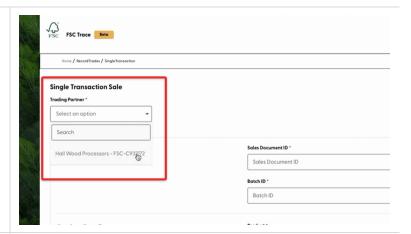

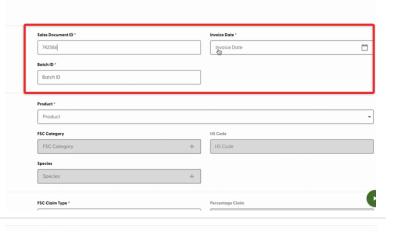
### 3 Select your trading partner

From the dropdown menu, specify your trading partner. FSC Trace will filter results to show only those you sell to.



# 4 Provide transaction identification information

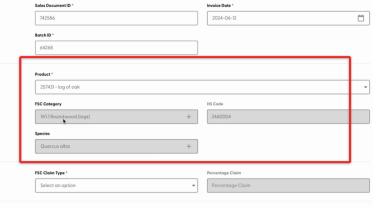
Complete fields such as sales document ID (invoice number) and invoice date.
You can also choose to add a batch ID number.



#### 5 Specify the product in the sale

Select your product from the dropdown menu. FSC Category, HS Code and Species are auto filled from preexisting information.

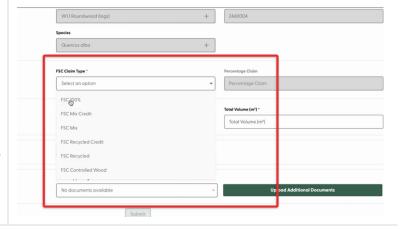
Product selection will be pulled from already configured items. If your page does not match, you will need to configure your products first.



## 6 Select FSC Claim type in the sale

Choose claim type from the drop-down menu, e.g. FSC 100%, FSC MIX, or FSC Controlled Materials. Claim type should match the one stated on your certificate or license.

If you choose the FSC MIC or FSC MIX credit, you need to specify the percentage of FSC claim.

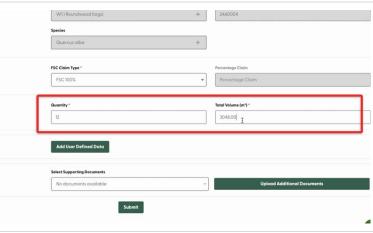

# 7 Define the number of products sold on this invoice

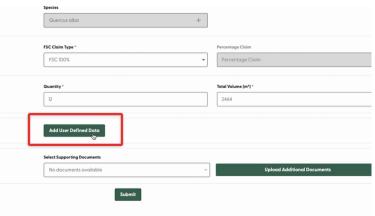
FSC Trace will automatically calculate volume based on prior information supplied.

If the automated result does not correspond, you can manually override the calculation.



#### 8 Add user defined data

You can upload additional documents like harvesting permits or client data points. Click submit to finalise the sale transaction.



## 9 Inspect and edit your transaction
