FSC Risk Assessment Consultations



1. Overview

- This guidance provides an overview of FSC's Risk Assessment consultations and how to stay engaged and participate. FSC's consultations are open to all interested stakeholders.

2. FSC Risk Assessment Framework

FSC-PRO-60-006b FSC Risk Assessment

<u>Framework</u> provides a comprehensive tool for companies to assess and mitigate the risks of sourcing forest materials.

With 64 indicators for assessing risks connected to relevant social and environmental aspects, FSC's Risk Assessment Framework is aligned with EUDR regulatory requirements to ensure responsible sourcing. The next generation of FSC's existing risk assessments for controlled wood sourcing will be based on this updated framework and will be valid for both **Regulatory Module users** and Controlled Wood users. 3. Consultations for FSC Risk Assessment development and revision

Following FSC's Risk Assessment Framework, all FSC Risk Assessments developed centrally will have a focused consultation.

A focused consultation is one in which ALL stakeholders can self-identify as interested in a particular normative revision/ development. Once a stakeholder self-identifies, they will be actively contacted to participate in the consultation.

The rationale for differentiating between public and focused consultations was to streamline FSC processes, wherein only interested stakeholders are invited to participate. This is also expected to reduce stakeholder fatigue with all the ongoing FSC consultations.

5. Using FSC's Consultation Platform

All country requirements consultations are posted to the FSC Consultation Platform. Standard developers can also build their platforms if they better suit the needs of their constituency. As such, country requirements consultations are not visible when opening the <u>FSC Consultation</u> <u>Platform page</u>, as they are not defined as "public" in our normative requirements. We are working on an updated Consultation Platform to differentiate this better and allow for better user orientation.
