### Change Type Legend

#### Amended

Requirements that have been modified, clarified, improved, and/or expanded.

#### New

Newly introduced requirement in V5-0 of FSC-STD-20-001 or from ISO 17065:2012

#### Replaced

Requirement merged with or substituted by ISO 17065 text and not retained as a separate clause in V5-0.

#### Removed

Requirements from Version 4-0 that have been deleted and are not reflected in Version 5-0.

#### No change

Text that may differ editorially, while the intent and requirements remain unchanged.

#### Not applicable

Used for headings or subheadings that are not subject to comparison.



### Tip for Navigation:

Start with the V5-0 column, then compare ISO 17065 and V4-0.

Readers are encouraged to review the document column-by-column, starting with V5-0, to observe how each requirement is carried forward or modified. Notes and comments included throughout the file provide additional clarity where necessary.

- Identify updated or new requirements for implementation.
- Conduct gap analyses for transition planning.
- Support training & communication on changes.
